

Creative Curriculum Theme – Superheroes

Personal, Social and Emotional

- Talk about who is special to us and why.
- Develop deeper understanding of own needs, wants, interests and opinions.

Understanding the World

- Explore people who help us and our very own superheroes.
- Discuss similarities and differences between ourselves and others.

Expressive Arts and Design

- Experiment with colour, design and texture.
- Use role play area as a Superhero HQ to develop imagination and language.
- Design and create our own superhero badge.

English

We will read 'Ten Little Superheroes' by Mike Brownlow and 'Supertato' by Sue Hendra

- Revisit 42 individual letter sounds and learn alternative spellings of sounds.
- Practise reading and writing tricky words.
- To take part in guided reading sessions.
- Use capital letters, full stops and finger spaces to write simple sentences.

Maths

- Solve problems, including doubling, halving and sharing.
- Add and subtract two-single digit numbers.
- Use mathematical language to describe everyday objects and shapes.

Physical Development

- Talk about ways to keep healthy and safe
- Represent my own ideas, thoughts and feelings through dance.

Communication and Language

- Listen to stories and ask relevant questions.
- Answer 'how' and 'why' questions about their experiences.

Music

- Children sing songs, make music and dance, and experiment with ways of changing them.
