

Phonics Opportunities

- Write different letters using chalk, shout one out at a time and use a water pistol/spray bottle or a wet paintbrush to shoot or splat the right letter.
- Hide some treasure and create a map to help someone to find it. Have a go at writing some clues and tell a grown up what your marks mean.
- Use blankets and cushions to make a reading den.
Read a fairytale story with a grown up, have a go at retelling it or acting it out.

Maths Opportunities

- Write different numbers/draw different shapes using chalk, shout one out at a time and use a water pistol/spray bottle or a wet paintbrush to shoot or splat the right number/shape.
- Go on a maths scavenger hunt: e.g. Find 2 socks, 1 teddy and 3 spoons—how many things do you have altogether? Find 5 blocks, take 2 away, how many left?
- Use things in the house to make your own shop. Can you have a go at writing some numbers for price tags or count out coins to buy an item.



Get creative

- Create rainbow leaf rubbings
- Explore floating and sinking with different objects in the bath.
- Draw or paint your favourite character from a storybook.
- Create your own road/miniature town using masking tape, toy cars and figures.



Get outdoors

- Paint a picture on a stone.
- Place different shaped objects in the sun and draw around their shadows.
- Draw out a wiggly line using chalk or string—balance and follow the line by walking along it?
- Play a game of 'What's the time Mr. Wolf?'
