- Write a letter (aim for 1 page) to your local MP discussing what you would like to be done in Wombourne to improve it and how it would benefit the local community—it could be a new park, a new leisure centre or shopping centre.
- Write a story (aim for at least 2 pages) set at the beach, a park, a holiday resort or theme park. Think about what the characters see, hear, smell and touch. Make sure to use different sentence types (2A, 3A, BIOBS, exclamation, ed sentences)
- Draw an exciting front cover for your book and write a Blurb for the back cover.

- Read aloud to an adult, putting on different voices for each character.
- Write some of your own questions about the book you have read and answer them.
- Write your own blurb for the book you have read.
- Choose 1 or 2 pages from the book and write 3 adjectives, verbs, nouns and adverbs from those pages.




## Maths

- Practise the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables.
- Compare the weight of foods in your house use mathematical vocabulary such as —more/less than and heavier/lighter also use symbols  $<$   $>$   $=$
- Draw 5 fruits and give them a price. Write some questions and answer them - I buy 2 apples and 3 pears with a £2. How much change will I get?
- Write some of your own time word problems and answer them - James needed to be at his friends house by 5 o'clock. It takes 20 minutes to walk there. What time does James need to leave his house by?
- Use mathematical vocabulary to direct a family member to an item that you have hidden inside your house—describe the position, direction and movement, including movement in a straight line and distinguishing between rotation as a turn and in terms of right angles for quarter, half and three-quarter turns (clockwise and anticlockwise).

## Creative - Street Detectives

- Write about the different jobs that support the community and why they are important.
- Show community spirit by writing a letter to cheer up somebody who is on their own at the moment.
- Draw a map of somewhere that you have walked recently—what did you see, smell, hear and touch? Draw a key showing these different things and differentiate between the different senses.
- Design a leaflet explaining to people how they can help look after our environment.
- Draw and label a design for your own fantasy home. What will your home be built from? How will you get in and out of your house? What will you have in your garden? Make a model of your fantasy house using junk materials.
