- Use exciting sentence types like De:de sentences, Noun, who, which, where and adjective, same adjective sentences.




Reading and Spelling

- Practise spelling these homophones correctly and using the correct form in sentences : there, their and they're. Wear and where. Rein, reign and rain.

- Practise Times Tables Rock stars and Year 4 Multiplication check on line.

- Estimate the area and perimeter of rooms in your house or garden if you can.
 Remember area = length x width. Perimeter = add up all lengths of each side.
- If you can find a measuring tape at home, try to measure the area and perimeter of each room.



Creative - Blue Abyss

- Choose a range of living organism pictures e.g. fish, parrot, elephant, whale, flower, frog etc. and create a classification key to sort them into groups. Use only yes or no answers - e.g. Does it lay eggs? Does it have feathers?
- Research the layers of the ocean and its different zones. Find out what sea creatures can live in each zone.
