- Write a letter (aim for 1 page) based on finding a secret community living in a hidden place e.g. underground beneath a train station, in the woodlands, over the horizon, at the end of the rainbow or on a cloud.
- Write a poem about your family or community—remember there should be a capital to start every line. Try performing the poem to your family.
- Create a comic strip, base your comic on superheroes in our community e.g. doctors, nurses, police, fire fighters, paramedics.

Reading



- Read aloud to an adult, putting on different voices for each character.
- After reading to an adult, ask them questions about what you have read—see if they can get them answer correct!
- Identify words that has suffixes –ment, –ness, –ful, –less, –ly and then write a sentence of your own using this spelling.




Maths

- Practise the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables—try the 6 and 7 times tables if you are feeling confident!
- Experiment with multiplication calculations to see if you can write the numbers in a different order and it still work e.g. $2 \times 10 = 20$, $10 \times 2 = 20$. Can you notice a pattern? Explain your findings.
- Learn the number of minutes in an hour and the number of hours in a day.
- Order and arrange combinations of shapes in patterns and sequences. You can make different patterns and sequences by drawing different shapes or using different colours.
- Construct simple pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and simple tables. You might want to use the internet to collect information for your tally chart or ask your family e.g. ask you family their favourite animal, or flavour of crisp or pizza topping. Then you can make a tally chart, pictogram or bar chart to show your findings.

Creative - Street Detectives

- Explore your house and garden; what manufactured or natural materials can you find? Choose your own way of recording your findings.
- Show community spirit by writing a letter to cheer up somebody who is on their own at the moment.
- Make your own sign posts to help look after your local community, add a picture to make it eye-catching e.g. Be kind, Wash your hands regularly. Place it in your window.
- Draw and label a design for your own fantasy garden. How will you use the space? Will you grow any vegetables or fruits? Will you have somewhere to sit or have a barbeque? Will you have a play area? Any flowers or trees?
