

## Explore music and movement

- Create lines using tape or string—can you walk along the line? Jump over it?
- Make a drum and drum to the beat of a favourite song or nursery rhyme.
- Go on a sound hunt and find objects around the house that make different sounds



## Maths Opportunities

- Practise counting and reciting number names in order as you walk up steps/ stairs.
- Find objects of the same colour around the house—can you count them?
- Draw around different household objects and match the objects to the correct outlines.



## Get creative

- Sensory play (porridge oats and food colouring, shaving foam etc.)
- Practise cutting with safety scissors—strips of paper, strands of cooked spaghetti or playdough.
- Create a butterfly painting by making marks on one side and folding the picture in half to make a print.



## Get outdoors

- Mark marks with water in puddles using a paintbrush.
- Colour hop—Draw different coloured circles in chalk and jump onto the correct colour when you shout it out.
- Make a bird feeder using a kitchen roll tube, string, seeds and peanut butter.
