

## Phonics/Reading Opportunities

- Draw a story map for a traditional fairy tale.
- Play or make a musical instrument to play along to Jolly Phonics jingles for each letter of the alphabet (Youtube—Jolly Phonics)
- Create finger puppets and tell your own story by putting on a puppet show.
- Make up your own story, starting with Once upon a time...



## Get creative

- Use recyclable materials to make a chair for baby bear.
- Create a bridge for the Three Billy Goats.
- Draw or paint a picture of a land at the top of a beanstalk.
- Make and decorate your own gingerbread people.



## Maths Opportunities

- Read the story of The Gingerbread man— can you count how many people/animals he runs away from?
- Use 2D shapes to make a fairy tale castle
- Write numbers 1-12 on stones or paper to create your own clock.
- Whilst baking or cooking, help with measuring out ingredients.



## Get outdoors

- Plant beans to grow your own beanstalk.
- Use sticks/things found outside to make a house for the Three little pigs.
- Create a giants footprint.
- Create a den to shelter from the rain.
