- Practise spelling plural words that have 's' or 'es'. Can you think of 5 words of each? E.g. fox—foxes, pan—pans

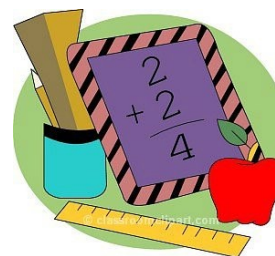
**Reading and Phonics**
