- Practise spelling words that end in 'ing'. Can you think of 10 words? E.g. sing—singing, run—running

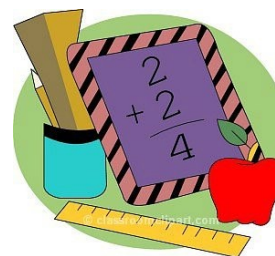
Reading and Phonics
