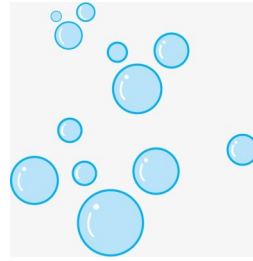


## Explore music and movement

- Blow bubbles and move in different ways to catch and pop them!
- Sing favourite nursery rhymes and action rhymes, try filling in the missing word from a familiar rhyme e.g. Humpty Dumpty sat on a ...
- Attach a balloon to a surface using string and practise hand eye co-ordination to try and hit it in different directions.



## Get creative

- Make your own finger puppets and use your imagination as you play!
- Create your own roleplay area using a cardboard box—decorate it using crayons/felt tips, make a window etc.
- Make mouldable moon sand (4 cups flour, 1/2 cup baby oil)
- Make a treasure basket to explore, full of different textured items and materials

## Maths Opportunities

- Print patterns in playdough with different shapes or blocks such as Megablocks or Duplo.
- Sort toys and household objects by colour - how many different colours can you find?
