

Explore music and movement

- Play a sorting game using different objects— which objects make a sound, which do not?
- Play music and clap hands to the beat or bounce a teddy on your knee (develop a sense of rhythm)
- Play 'sleeping bunnies' - practise being still and then jumping up to hop: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=V9J_DqEwZdc

Maths Opportunities

- Recite numbers in order and use fingers to count as you sing '1,2,3,4,5,once I caught a fish alive'.
- Explore counting by using a muffin tin and cake cases .

Get creative

- Paint a flower picture using forks
- Make a 'stained glass' butterfly using different coloured paper
- Sensory play with Jelly (You could put objects inside the jelly before it sets)
