- Practice reading the days of the week and the months of the year.
- How many words can you think of that have sh or ch in them? Sound button them.
- Play a game on Phonics Bloom (phase 3-5)

<u>Maths</u>

- How many different ways can you make 20p?
- Get 2 pieces of paper. Fold on in half and the other in quarters. Label them.
- Write your numbers to 50. Colour your even numbers in blue and the odd numbers in red.

- Choose 5 numbers. How many +/- can you make?
