- Why does he/she have tooth ache? What has he been eating to get tooth ache? What kind of foods can he eat now? How will he get better?

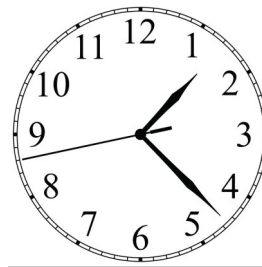
Reading and Spelling
