- Read Chapter 3 of The Lost Myth of Mathos on Purple Mash.
- Test your knowledge of the chapter by answering the brain-busting questions on Purple Mash.

## Spelling & Reading

- Use the read, cover, write strategy to learn the words: appear, consider, famous, important, often, quarter and although.
- Practise these spelling by putting them into interesting sentences.
- Read aloud to an adult, putting on different voices for each character.
- After reading to an adult, ask them questions about what you have read.



## Maths

- Have a go at looking at different the measurements grams/millilitres and convert them into kilograms/ litres.
- You can do this with anything including: water, objects and even ingredients in cooking!
- Compare different weights and record them into your book.
- How much does something weigh compared to another thing? How much exactly. Use your subtraction skills to find the difference.

- Make a fact sheet to compare events in the ancient and modern Olympic Games. You could use the activity set on Purple Mash to present your ideas.
- Challenge yourself to try out some of the activities from the ancient or modern Olympics. Could you be a gymnast, a runner or a cyclist? You could take some photographs to record your training.
