Grammar and Spelling

- Practise using the Year 5/6 spelling words in sentences.
- Practise using different types of punctuation e.g. .,/,':;(!)?
- Dictionary challenge: time how long it takes you to find a word in the dictionary. Try to beat your time from last week.

Maths

- Practise adding and subtracting fractions. Write problems involving fractions for an adult to solve.
- Rapidly recall all doubles and halves to 100 by heart.
- Design a game to practise halves and doubles e.g. halves and doubles snap.



Reading

- Rewrite a paragraph from your book in your own words. Could you improve it?
- Give the book a different title and front cover.
- Rewrite the blurb to persuade other children to read it.
- Write 5 questions you would ask the main character.

Creative — Beast Creator

- Create a mini beast word search and e-mail it to a friend to complete.
- Choose a different mini beast to research. Remember mini beasts can be found in seas, rivers and lakes. Present your findings in a different way.
- Find out the scientific names for mini beasts and how they can be sorted e.g. spiders can be classified as arachnids.
- Create a mini beast quiz to test a friend's knowledge.
