- Write a recipe for a Mexican dish of your choice. Look online to find different recipes and then re-write it. Remember to use imperative verbs and clear, concise instructions.
- Write a non-chronological report about Chichén Itza temple. Remember to include: a main heading, introductory paragraph, subheadings and concluding paragraph. Use labelled diagrams and technical vocabulary too.



Grammar and Spelling

- Design a poster to help someone learn to spell common homophones—for example, there, their and they're, to, two and too. The poster should give the reader a way to remember which spelling should be used when.
- Define a fronted adverbial and provide 6 examples of fronted adverbials.



Maths

Ratio - write a recipe for a fruit smoothie. Write the quantity of ingredients needed to make 1 smoothie, 5 smoothies and 20 smoothies. Remember to check that you have put the units of measure.

Calculation - use a dice to create a 4 digit number and a 2 digit number. Multiply the 4 digit number by the 2 digit number. Divide the 4 digit number by the 2 digit number - if it doesn't go in exactly, write your remainder as a decimal (round the remainder to 2 decimal places, if required).

- Create 3 retrieval questions for the myth.
- Create an inference question for the myth.
