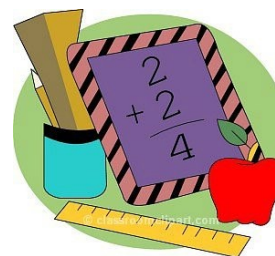
- Write instructions of how to wash your hands. Draw pictures to go with your sentences.

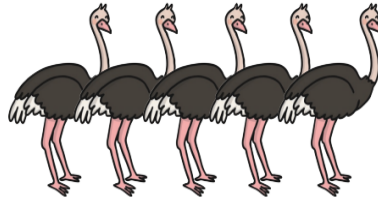

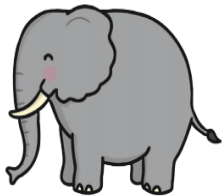
Safari Themed Challenge Cards



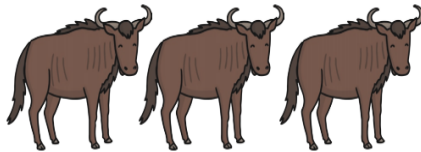
1. 7 ostriches run through the desert. They join a group of 9 ostriches. How many are there now?

4. 14 meerkats are foraging for food. An eagle flies over and 7 run away. How many are left?

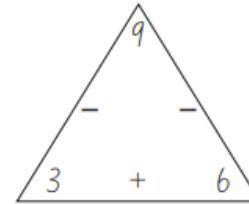


5. 13 vultures are sitting in a tree. 5 more fly down to join them. How many vultures are in the tree?

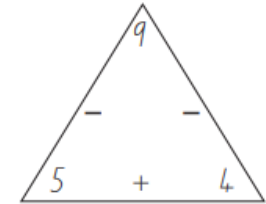

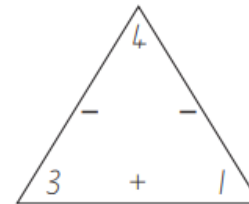

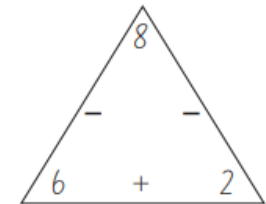
