- Choose 10 common exception words that you find tricky to spell. Practise writing them.

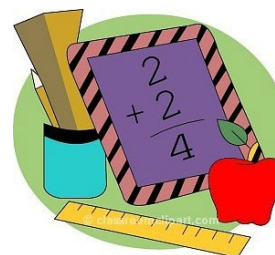
Reading and Phonics
