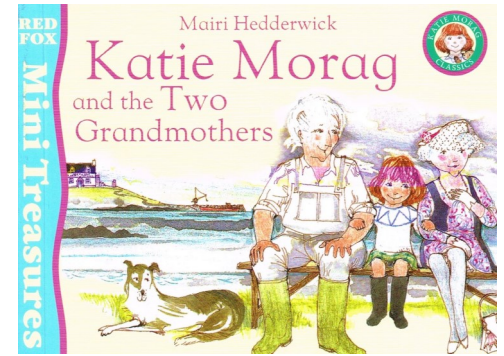


English

- How does Grandma Mainland travel to the island? Have you ever been on a boat? Or an aeroplane? Write a few sentences about an exciting journey you have been on.

Phonics and Reading

- Ask your grown up to write some alien (nonsense) words for you to sound out and blend using your phonics. E.g, rom, dup, lomf, shimk
- Use your Oxford Owl login to read a book.
- Practise your letter formation. If you have a tablet, you could try using purple mash 2handwrite to have go at forming your graphemes with lead ins.
- Practise your tricky words.



Maths - Solving problems

- Katie Morag has 8 sweets. Her brother Liam has 6 sweets. How many do they have altogether?
- At the fair, there are 9 cupcakes to share between three winners. How many will they get each?
- Katie has five special pebbles. Liam needs five pebbles too. How many will her and her brother Liam need?
- Liam has 8 raffle tickets from the fair. He gives half of them to Katie. How many do they have each?

Creative - Where I Live

Watch the video of Katie Morag introducing where she lives on the Isle of Struay—<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=lx6oyVgUDbc> What places are there to visit? Are there lots of buildings? What is different to where you live? Beaches, hills, farms—are there any places like this near Wombourne?

- Task 1- What is your home like? Is it a house, a flat, a bungalow? Draw a picture of your home from the outside and label it.
- Task 2 - Where do you live? Is it a town or a village? Make a list of things you like to do in Wombourne or the place you live. This could be a local walk, play park or café that you like to visit.
- Task 3 - With a grown up, have a look at an aerial view of where you live. E.g. On Google maps. Talk about the things you can see—trees, buildings, roads. Can you find your street and home from above?
- Task 4 - Think of yesterday's aerial view. Make a map showing how to get from your home to your favourite place in Wombourne to visit.
- Task 5 - Think of another nice place you have visited. This could be the seaside or a city. What did it have that is the same as Wombourne. What was different? Draw a picture to show the similarities and differences.
