Maths



We will read: 'Sparks in the Sky' (A Twinkl story), 'Stick Man' by Julia Donaldson and 'The Jolly Christmas Postman' by Janet & Allan Ahlberg

We will explore and begin to learn our sounds and letters through Jolly Phonics.

We will have fun retelling the story of 'Stick Man' through indoor and outdoor play.

We will create Christmas lists by cutting pictures from catalogues and making marks to represent writing a letter to Santa.

Understanding the World

Let's learn about the seasons. What happens in each season and how does the weather change?

Let's explore colour, light and dark, and observe similarities, differences and changes.

Let's learn about different events and festivals that are celebrated around the world.

We will play counting games and explore different ways of recording ideas of number.

We will explore 2D shapes in the environment and create our own shape rockets.

We will develop an understanding of size, shape and weight by sorting, measuring and weighing presents in Santa's workshop.

We will explore problem solving with the help of our mischievous 'Elf on the shelf!'

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be super creative and make firework paintings using different techniques and tools.

We will make links between 'people who help us' through firefighter small world play.
