English

Our work in English will be based on the book 'Diver's Daughter' by Patrice Lawrence.

We will discover what Tudor life was like from the perspective of a young slave girl and tell that story through a historical narrative.

We will debate the ethics of Tudor blood sports by writing and actively debating the rights and wrongs of this Tudor pastime.

One of the most famous writers of all time William Shakespeare was a Tudor and we will be using him as a guide to write our own play scripts.

PSHE

This half term, children will be focusing on 'Me and My School'

Children will be actively involved in choosing the rules they would like to help make their class a happy and supportive place to be.

We will look at strategies the children can use to help overcome any challenges they may face in their learning such as the 'Thoughts and Feelings' box with in our classroom

We will also be recognising our achievements and setting new goals.
