I hope you are having a lovely Friday, safe in the knowledge that the children will all be returning to school on Monday. We are eagerly awaiting the buzz of having everyone back in their classrooms.

There has been a lot of discussion in the media, and probably in households, about the role of parents, teachers and children during this lockdown. One thing that stands out is that everyone has had to work extremely hard to make it possible and I thank you and your families for your role in that.

The start and finish times for all classes is on the next page along with a reminder of PE days and Forest school days when children should not wear their uniform to school. This timetable will operate up until Easter.

When you come to drop off or collect your child on Monday, please be mindful of the necessities for social distancing on the playground. We continue to operate the same procedures at the start and the end of the day. Please try not to arrive before your allotted time to avoid congestion. The markings on the playground have been spaced for safety so please adhere to them. The basketball court is used for children in Years 3 and 4 to line up, so we ask that parents do not walk across/into this space. The steps onto the key stage 1 playground have a one way up and one way down system in place and anyone with a pushchair should use the ramp to access the lower playground rather than the grass slope. Ideally only one adult should accompany your child/ren.

Adults on school premises and in the nearby areas should wear a face mask and may be approached by a member of staff if they aren't. While secondary school pupils are required to wear masks in school, this is not true for primary school children.

There will be members of staff in each of the areas should there be any queries or questions.
